


Choosing a Restaurant



Section 1: Dialogue

Please read the following dialogue between a hotel guest and an information receptionist's at a hotel.

Guest: Hi, may I ask you if there are any good restaurants near here?

Guest: The boardwalk sounds great! I just have one last question. My wife and I are planning to celebrate our 10th anniversary. Would you kindly suggest a restaurant with an outdoor patio and a view of the city skyline?

Information Officer: If you're looking for a spectacular view of the city, you could make a reservation at the revolving restaurant located at the top most floor of A&M Building in Central town. And another place of interest is at Pleasant Hills. High up on the mountain side, you'll have the best view of the city skyline. Vocabulary Word	Definition	Sample Sentence
cuisine [kwi'zēn] noun	a style or method of cooking, especially as characteristic of a particular country, region, or establishment.	Much Italian cuisine is based on pasta.
ambiance [ambēəns] noun	the character and atmosphere of a place.	The relaxed ambience of the cocktail lounge is popular with guests.
cozy [kōzē] adjective	giving a feeling of comfort, warmth, and relaxation.	We stayed in a cozy cabin tucked away in the forest.
authentic [ô'THentik] adjective	of undisputed origin; genuine.	the Jordan shoes are authentic.
discrete [dis'krēt] adjective	individually separate and distinct.	Whale communities were sometimes thought of as discrete communities, seldom mixing.
revolve [ri'vôlv/] verb revolving = present participle	move in a circle on a central axis.	"overhead, the fan revolved slowly"
