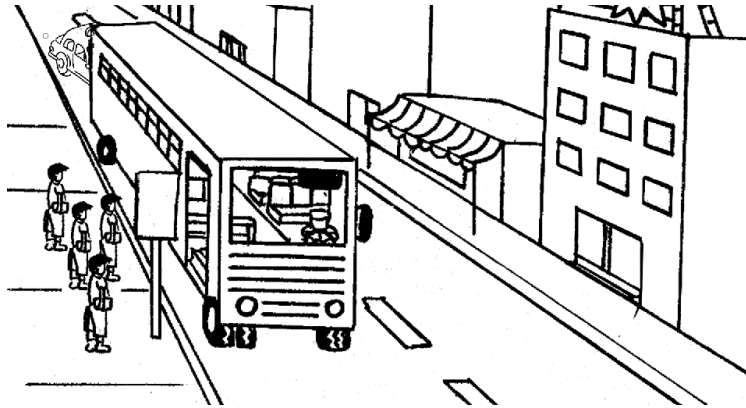


## TAKING A BUS

Vocabulary Word	Sample sentence
passenger [pas-uh n-jer] noun	There were forty passengers waiting in the terminal.
officer [aw-fuh-ser, of-uh-] noun	My father was an officer in the bus terminal.
straight ahead [streyt-uh-hed] Adverb phrase	Go straight ahead, and then move it toward the right.
