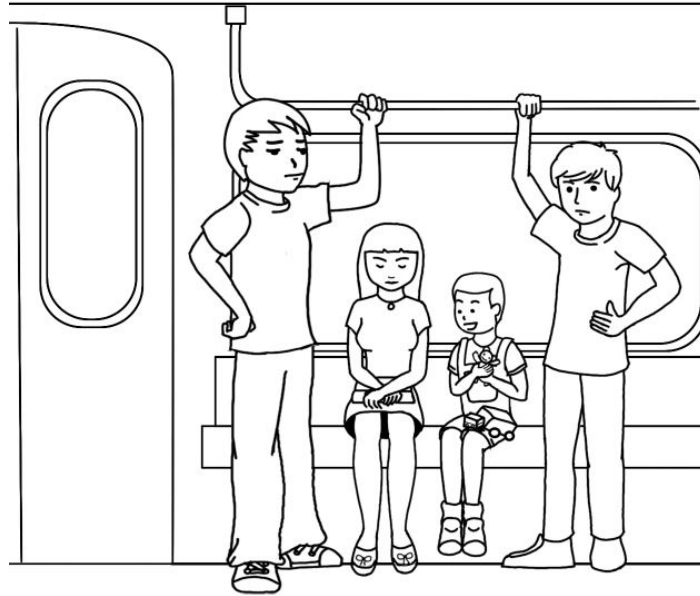


TAKING THE TRAIN

pleasure <i>[plezh-er]</i> noun	It was a pleasure to meet you.
