



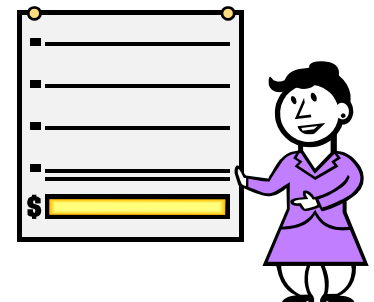
How can I come back to a topic?
